Super Simple Pumpkin Cookies

1 box spice cake mix

1 15 oz. can pumpkin puree

6 oz. white chocolate chips (optional)

Winter Survival Lifehacks

Winter is right around the corner. After living in Alaska for 7 years I've picked up a few tricks to keep you on the road and safe.

1. Kitty litter if you're stuck. Kitty litter is one of the best traction creators out there. Even when it's wet kitty litter will still clump up and create traction.
2. Bug spray for clear head lights. Bug spray applied to your head lights with a cloth will clear up dull lenses and it also coats the lens in a thin layer of oil preventing ice build up.
3. Shaving cream for anti-fogging. Apply shaving cream to the inside of your windshield and wipe it away. Shaving cream has some of the same ingredients as commercial anti-foggers.
4. Use the power of the sun. Park your car facing East, it will thaw from the direct sun light.
5. Blanket your car. Placing a old blanket or beach towel over you windshield when it is suppose to snow will prevent you from having to scrape and sweep your windshield off. Just pull the blanket off and get going.
6. Sandwich bag your mirrors. Placing large sandwich bags over your mirrors before it snows, just like the blanket method above this will keep you from having to scrape your mirrors.
7. Remember to always have a emergency kit in your car. Water and non-perishable food, A small shovel, first aid kit, and blankets.
