Memorial Award Secretary Report



The United States Jaycees offers a variety of awards to honor states, chapters, and individuals. One of these awards is the Harold A. Marks Memorial Award.

The Harold Marks Memorial Award is the highest achievement within the United States Junior Chamber. The chapter receiving this award is chosen from the Clarence H. Howard Memorial Award winners and is recognized as the Most Outstanding Junior Chamber Chapter in the nation.

The award is in honor of Harold Marks, a former Phoenix, Arizona Jaycee, who was killed in an airplane crash March, 1936 along with three other members of the Junior Chamber.

The award was first set up in 1937. The first award recognized the most outstanding local president, Ben Hadley of Columbus, Ohio. By 1940, the awards shifted from a president award into a chapter award. Then from 1940 to 1948, multiple chapters were eligible to win, but from 1949 on, only one chapter each year would be awarded this high honor.
